UNISON is a stand-alone application designed to automate dictionary maintenance in the MEDITECH environment. Within 20 minutes a user can create the sync and scheduled it to take place regularly without human intervention.

MEDITECH mandates that you build your dictionaries in test before you go live with an upgrade, but they don't offer to move your dictionaries or they charge thousands to do it. Even then, most hospitals find that what came to Live status is not correct and lacks the functionality they were expecting. UNISON allows users to quickly automate the synchronizing of any depart-

mental dictionary in the MEDITECH environment, and you have complete control of which dictionaries are synchronized and when you want the syncs to occur.

UNISON provides an easy to use set-up wizard that steps the user through the selection of the specific data required from the first dictionary, then walks the user through the process of updating a record into the second dictionary. UNISON develops a reliable sync that will accurately and automatically update the dictionary. The sync may be scheduled to run at any appropriate interval and any exceptions are written to an audit file for review. Using UNISON, dictionary maintenance takes less than 20 minutes and the entire test to live process is automated. You can be assured your dictionary records are fully updated. It's that easy.

UNISON is a stand-alone application that uses some embedded technology provided by Boston WorkStation Version 9. If Unison is co-installed on a PC with Boston WorkStation that instance of Boston WorkStation must be version 9.

If you are installing UNISON for Meditech Magic, please be sure you have the installed the mrwscript.dll (see Special Meditech Instructions)
